

How to register to attend the event

- If you cannot attend a session anymore, please cancel your registration so another participant can take your place.

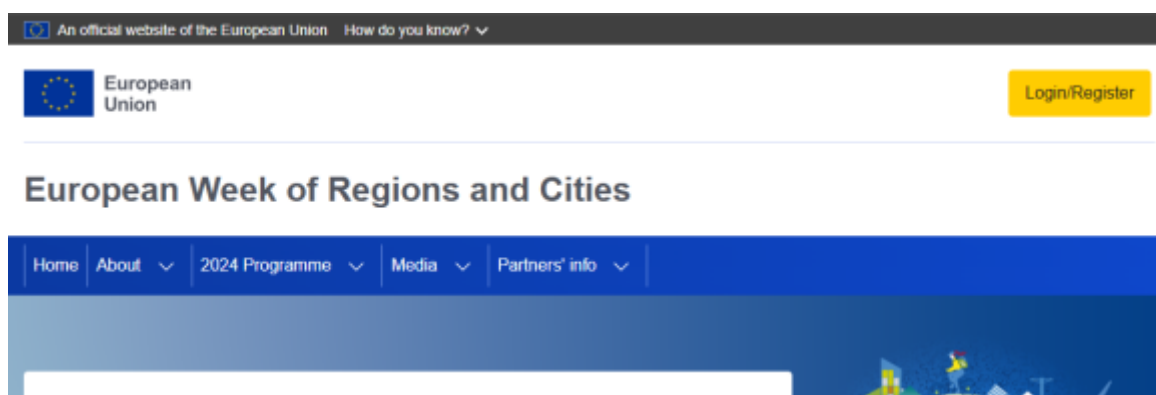

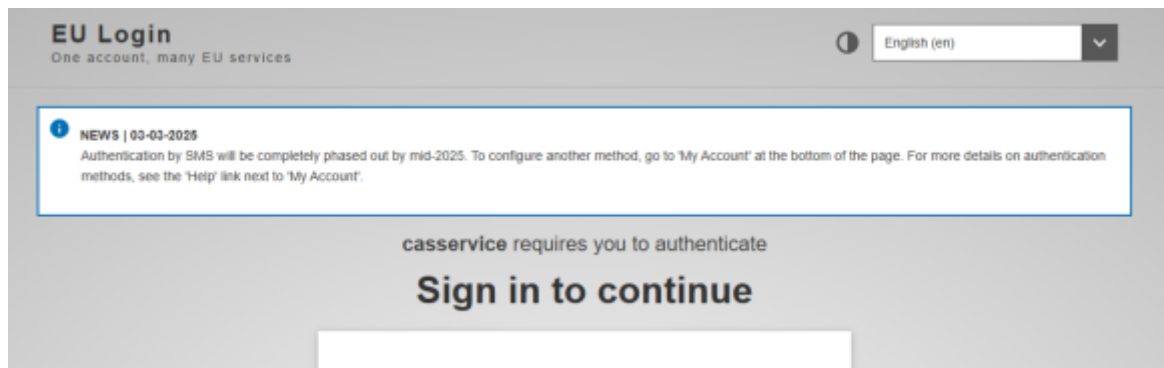

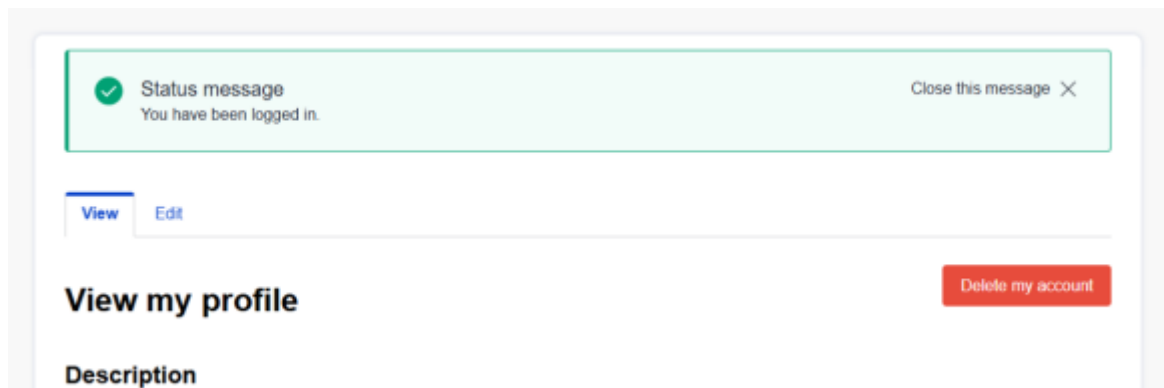
Click on **Login/Register** in the top right corner of the homepage.
