





'PIMA Climate Change' regional funds are planned to support municipalities to prepare their urban and peripheral areas for climate change effects.

Xunta de Galicia required municipalities to apply to this fund with proposals that are part of their SECAPs.

Our government will mobilized nearly 0.8 M€ in PIMA CC funds for SECAP's adaptation actions in nearly 45 municipalities of Galicia during 2023 and 2024.
