Challanges in cohesion funds implementation

- Intricate Administrative Processes: overlapping regulations, excessive workloads, poor interoperability (affecting small municipalities)
- Spending Inefficiencies: fraud, irregularities, delays undermine funds' credibility
- Lack of Public Awareness: citizens unaware of investments' impact





The role of Al: addressing key applications

- Predictive Analytics: Anticipating delays or issues in projects for more informed decision making
- Automation of Administrative Controls:
 Simplifying verification processes and timing
- Anomaly & Fraud Detection: Identifying suspicious patterns in data minimizing risks
- Simplification of Reporting: Chatbots and userfriendly tools for easier communication





Our approach for Al in Public Administration

- Al should be a "support, not a substitute"
- Human expertise remains central to effective management





Al4Funds Project: Smart Innovation in Cohesion Fund Management

- Automating First-Level Controls: Reduce verification time by 40%
- Spending Risk Prediction: Predict project delays and take corrective actions
- Smart Digital Assistance: Al conversational assistant for intuitive interactions
