1 CHALLENGE

Restate in your own words the main goal of your table.

2 DATA AND CONTEXT

Identify the inputs the AI model would need.
Which data sources are essential?
Which programme indicators / milestones / risks should be considered?
What context information (timeframe, regulation, geography) matters most?

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3 PROMPT DESIGN

Draft your AI prompt(s). Write one or two precise prompt formulations that address the objective. Ensure they are: 1. Specific and unambiguous; 2. Include key parameters or conditions; 3. Ask for outputs in plain, actionable language

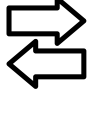

4 TESTING AND ITERATION

Plan how to check and refine your prompt. How will you test its robustness? What diverse inputs should be tried? How will you adjust and repeat? (Test, Tweak, Repeat)

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5 RISK AND BIAS AWARENESS

Identify possible pitfalls. What biases or blind spots could affect the model's response? How can we mitigate them? What human oversight is needed?



6 GOVERNANCE & USE IN REAL LIFE

Reflect on practical integration. How could this prompt be embedded in programme management workflows? Which authority or team would be responsible?
