## Forma NAEN project: cross-border training and employment, the challenges of mobility

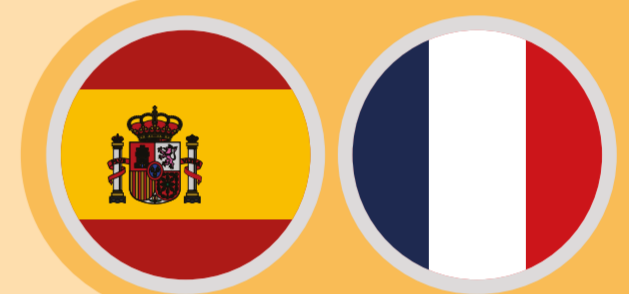

- Develop a qualified and specific vocational training offer for young people, adapted to the cross-border context and capable of offering real employment opportunities in the Euroregion

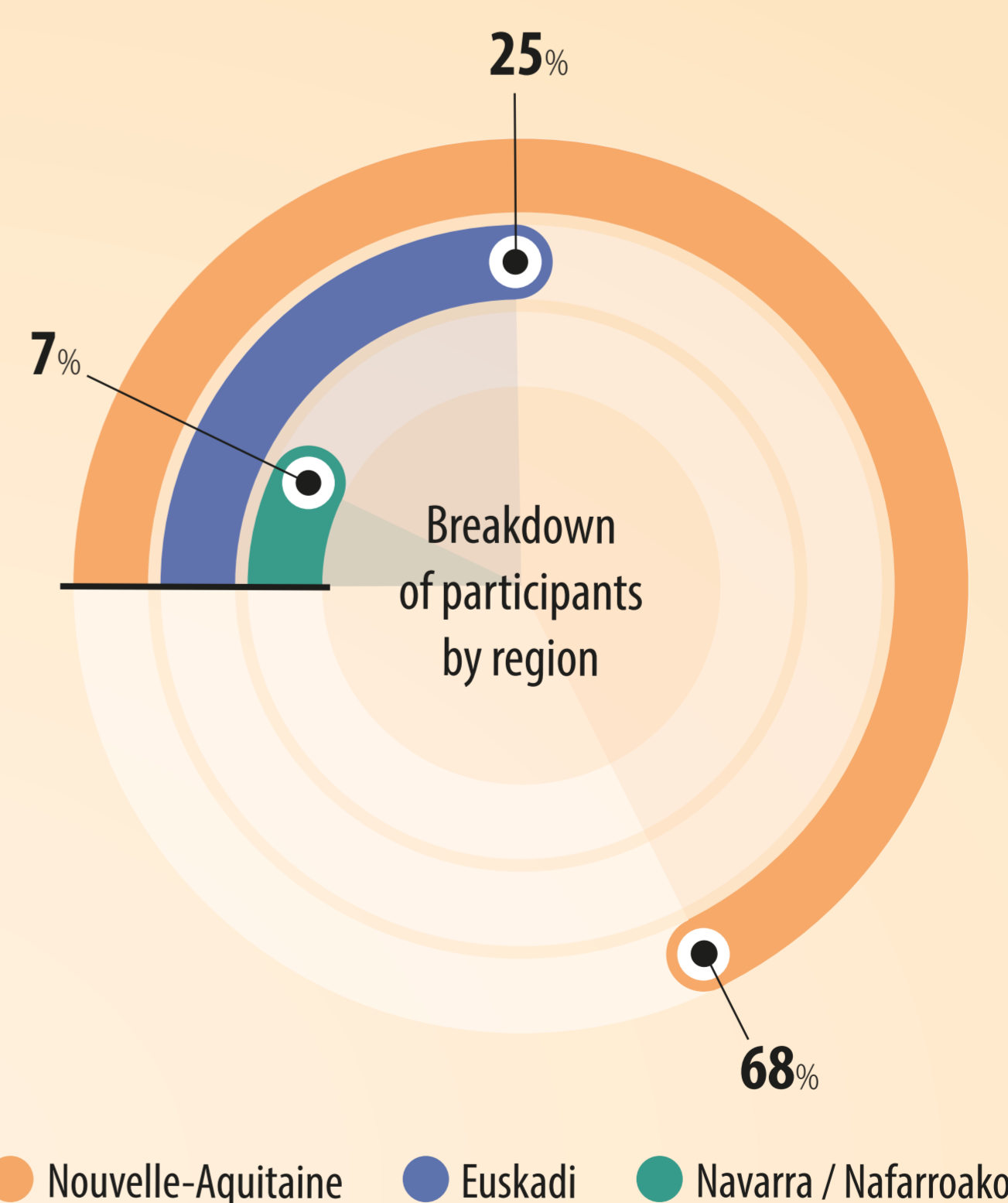
### Impact on local community:

- Employment opportunities and the potential of the regions
- Navarra (Spain) has adapted its training offer to provide the diploma also in French
