TeKiDe technology turns waste clothing into sustainable 'cottonfields'





## **Objectives:**

- Develop new techniques to transform wood fibres and discarded cotton fabrics into raw material for textile products
- Reduce the environmental impact of current production methods and promote circular economy
- Create an international innovation platform to test new ideas

## Impact on local community:

- The project gave the possibility to the VTT Technical Research Centre and the Aalto University, with the support of the Helsinki-Uusimaa Regional Council, to develop a new ground-breaking technique
- Birth of a Finnish start-up that started commercialising the production of recycled textile fibre such as used sheets and towels
