

- Build the second cycle bridge between Vysoká pri Morave (SK) and Marchegg (AT)
- Promote health and sustainable transport in the Morava River area
- Strengthen the cross-border ties between Bratislava Region and Lower Austria

- A boost to cycle tourism and ecotourism in a NATURA 2000 protected area
- The bridge also provides access to emergency services
- The bridges unite both communities and underlines the importance of cross-border cooperation and cultural exchange
